


Broadway sales remained strong in October, exceeding 2017 by more than \$4 million. Attendance was up on average nearly 11% this month compared to October 2017.

HOTELS Last 6 Months '15-'16








Average daily room rates rose in September while occupancy dipped slightly. These trends are consistent with previous years.


PED COUNTS Last 4 Weeks
